Enhancing Research Skills: 2024 Policy Formulation and Translation using DHS Data Survey, A Three-Day Training on STATA and DHS Data Analysis for CMAAE Students

Post-Graduate students enrolled in the Collaborative Masters of Agricultural and Applied Economics (CMAAE) program participated in a three-day intensive training program titled "2024 Policy Formulation and Translation using DHS Data Survey." Led by esteemed visiting Professor Kennedy Machira from Lilongwe University of Agriculture and Natural Resources (LUANAR), Malawi, the program aimed to equip students with advanced skills in utilizing STATA and Demographic and Health Survey (DHS) data for research and policy analysis.

Students then practiced conducting various regression analyses using STATA software.

Professor Machira further emphasized the importance of clear communication by guiding students in packaging their findings into impactful policy briefs. This intensive workshop is expected to significantly impact students throughout their academic journey, enabling them to conduct high-quality research, generate impactful publications, and contribute to evidence-based policy formulation in Kenya in their field of study.
