- i. Holders of 1st or 2nd Class Honors degrees from the University of Nairobi or equivalent institutions in fields related to agribusiness, business, social sciences, or natural sciences
- ii. Bachelor's degree holders in areas such as Agribusiness Management, Agricultural Economics, Agricultural Sciences, or related business disciplines with at least Upper Second Class Honors.
- iii. Lower Second Class Honors degree holders in relevant fields with at least two years' experience in agriculture or sector management.
- iv. Pass degree holders in Agribusiness Management from the University of Nairobi with five years of relevant experience.

- v. Pass degree holders in relevant areas with at least two years of experience and evidence of postgraduate training lasting at least six months.
- vi. Holders of Upper Second Class Advanced Diplomas and postgraduate diplomas with three years of work experience.

Scholarship opportunities may be available exclusively for applicants who have already been received the university admission and have started classes in September 2025, amongst meeting other criteria such as merit and need assessment.
