

**Call for Applications for the Kühne Logistics University (KLU) Summer School in Sustainability  
June 29 - July 17, 2026**

*Step into a dynamic, hands-on program designed for curious, motivated students ready to explore how sustainability is transforming industries!*

The LEARN Logistics by Kühne Foundation, a partner of the University of Nairobi, is offering **one scholarship** for a bachelor's (4<sup>th</sup> Year Level) or master's student (1<sup>st</sup> Year Level) from the University of Nairobi to participate in the Kühne Logistics University (KLU) Summer School in Sustainability, which will be held at KLU, June 29 - July 17, 2026, in Hamburg, Germany.

The objectives of the Summer School are:

- Assess a company's engagement in sustainability
- Recognize trade-offs between different sustainability efforts of a company
- Explain the complexity of corporate sustainability actions of companies
- Develop an informed personal perspective to evaluate corporate sustainability efforts
- Identify corporate sustainability practices and opportunities in a business environment
- Apply key sustainability concepts in a given situation
- Come home with a network of like-minded peers from around the world

### **Who can apply**

The program is open to fourth-year undergraduate and first-year masters students pursuing studies in Business, Agri-business, Logistics, Supply Chain Management and related programs at the University of Nairobi. Applicants who have previously participated in similar programs or have a DAAD scholarship through the Africa Centre of Excellence on Sustainable Operations in Resource Management and Food Supply (SCO) are not eligible.

### **Participation costs**

The LEARN Logistics by Kühne Foundation will cover **Tuition Fees** and arrange:

- Return flight in economy class
- Accommodation for three weeks at Holiday Inn Berliner Tor, including breakfast
- International health insurance

*Please note that any additional costs i.e., Schengen visa fee should be borne by the participant and meals.*

### **Application documents**

Application documents to be submitted should include:

1. Copy of national passport, student ID, and updated CV
2. Electronic copy of transcripts/proof of average grades
3. One-page motivation letter
4. Letter of recommendation from the Chairperson of your Department
5. Recognized English language qualification certificate (e.g., IELTS  $\geq$  6.0, TOEFL  $\geq$  60).  
Alternatively, a reference letter confirming English as the language of instruction is accepted.
