

Guest Lecture on Supply Chain Excellence and Sustainability

The Africa Centre of Excellence on Sustainable Operations for Resource Management and Food Supply (SCO) at the University of Nairobi in collaboration with the Kühne Foundation (KF), have organized a week long guest lecture on **Supply Chain Excellence and Sustainability** to be delivered by **Dr. Ullrich Förster**, a renowned expert in the field of supply chain management. The participants will also take part in an excursion to one of the companies in Kenya to "Go and See" – find the facts to make shared decisions, build consensus and propose solutions.

Who can apply

Participation costs

The Centre will meet the costs of the guest lecturer and travel costs for the field excursion. Therefore, selected participants will be expected to meet their own costs of participating in this program including writing materials, travel and meals.

Application documents

1. Hand signed motivation letter of not more than 1 page, written in Times New Romans, font size 12 and single spaced
2. Letter from the Chairman of your department confirming that you are a current student at the University of Nairobi admitted to any of the business related programs
3. Curriculum vitae (CV) that should include contact addresses of two referees
